We pay special attention to health education and value education classes as well. First Aid facilities are made available in the Physical Education Department and any minor injury is attended to by the Physical education department / Nurses.



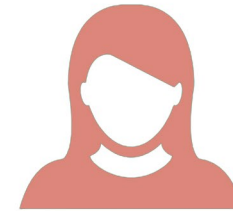

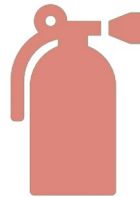

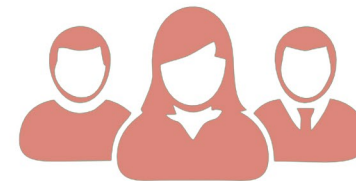

ADMISSION OF STUDENTS

Application form and prospectus can be had from school office on payment of Rs. 500/-. Filled in application must be accompanied by the attested copies of the following documents :-

1. Transfer Certificate
2. Birth Certificate (From the Municipal / Corporation authorities)
3. Conduct and Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
4. A passport size photograph of the Student must be affixed in the application
5. Aadhar Copy.

The Originals of the above mentioned certificates should be submitted at the time of admission.

FEE REGULATION

Fees have to be paid for the ten months of the year.

For convenience of the parents fees can be paid for each month / each term.

June - September (1st Term)

October - December (2nd Term)

January - March (3rd Term)

For defaulters fine of Rs. 150 will be collected for each term.



GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Students should strictly maintain discipline and decorum and shall not indulge in any activity detrimental to the interest of the institution. Severe action will be taken against those who do not conform to the above rules.
2. Parents are requested to sign the Late Attendance record, the absence record and also the complaints from the teachers that are written in the school diary.
3. We take remedial classes for better academic performance. This system is functioning effectively with proper individual attention by experienced faculty members. The school never encourages any private tuition.
4. The enrolment of the student in the school implies that the parents have agreed to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the school framed from time to time.
5. All correspondence regarding admission shall be made directly to the Principal.
7. Change of residential address of the student must be intimated to the school office immediately.
6. Application for the T .C. should be forwarded to the Principal by the Parent / Guardian after remitting Rs. 100/- at the School counter for the same.
7. Those who want to withdraw their wards, may apply for T.C. within 10 days after the announcement of result.
8. ESTABLISHMENT CHARGES AND FEES OF ANY NATURE ONCE PAID WILL NOT BE REFUNDED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

DISCIPLINE

1. Students should come to school clean, tidy and smartly dressed.
2. They should be regular and punctual in attending classes and all other activities connected with the school.
3. As a mark of courtesy, they shall greet their friends, classmates and the members of the staff.
4. All the Students are expected and encouraged to converse only in English in the school premises and outside to acquire greater fluency in the language.
5. No student should enter or leave the class room, without the permission of the teacher.
6. No meeting of any kind shall be held in the school premises without the prior permission of the Principal / Correspondent.
7. No notice of any kind shall be circulated or displayed on the notice board without the permission of the Principal. No information or report should be sent to the press or broadcasting agencies without the approval of the Principal / Correspondent.
8. Students are prohibited from defacing the walls or damaging the building or furniture in any way. If there is any damage caused, the cost will be recovered from the individual responsible and if the responsibility cannot be fixed on any one individual, it will be collected from the individuals concerned.
