Marian Senior Secondary School was established by Chevalier T. Thomas in 1979, aiming to provide children from lower middle-class families with an excellent education. Under the guidance of the Chevalier T Thomas Educational Trust, the school has made significant progress and is currently managed by Sri L Palamalai IAS (retd), the managing trustee and correspondent. Alongside Marian Senior Secondary School, the CTTE Trust also oversees other educational institutions such as St. Mary's Boys Matriculation School, St. Mary's Girls Matriculation Higher Secondary School, St. Mary's Matriculation Higher Secondary School, CTTE College for Women, and Primary School Kodungaiur.

One of the notable aspects of our school is the implementation of an integrated art curriculum, utilizing engaging and enjoyable learning methods. Furthermore, we offer an integrated batch for students aspiring to join medical and engineering programs. The 2022-2023 academic year commenced on June 1st, 2022, following comprehensive training and motivational classes provided to the teaching personnel and non-teaching staff.

To commemorate the dedication of our personnel, an alumni gathering was held on June 4th, 2022, bringing together graduates from the classes of 1997 to 2011 at the school premises. We take immense pride in our achievements in the regional youth festival, where we secured the first runner-up position with a total of 716 points. This accolade resulted in the award of seven trophies, including the first runner-up position in various categories such as Cat. 1, 3, and 4. Our school excelled in Margamkali and instrumental music categories, securing runner-up positions. Additionally, we attained the runners-up position in the senior secondary category.

In category three, our school achieved exceptional results with second place and an A grade in Group Dance Girls, first place and an A grade in Margam Kali Girls, and third place and an A grade in Oppana Girls. Furthermore, in category four, our Margam Kali Girls and Thiruvathirakali Girls secured third and second places, respectively, both earning A grades.
